

Code of Conduct for Adults Supervising Children

- 1. No single adult (coach, manager, instructor, etc.) will be alone with any child.
- 2. There must be at least two (2) adult leaders (members of the organization) delivering the program on site. It is also recommended that another adult be "on call" to help in case of emergency, if a leader must leave the site.
- 3. Transportation adult leaders should not be transporting children without the express written permission from the parents for that day and time.
- 4. It is the parents' responsibility to deliver their children on time and pick them up on time. Adult leaders are to call the Mt. Olive Police if children are not picked up after twenty minutes from program end time.
- 5. Coaches cannot leave the site until every child is picked up.
- 6. Recreation programs are for our children, no program can be successful unless parents are involved.
- 7. Respect Adult leaders will respect the rights of the players, parents, officials, coaches, etc. Parents should show respect to officials, coaches, adult leaders, players and parents of the players. Children should show respect to all adults and to all the other children. Un-sportsmanship-like behavior will not be tolerated.
